Dear LUHS District Parents and Guardians,

I hope this week finds you and your family well!

The anticipation of the Safer-at-Home order left us worried that we would be restricted from being able to continue the services we are providing to students and families during the state-wide school closure. Fortunately, our governmental leaders see education, food service, and mental health services as essential, so we will be able to continue services currently in place for students and families.


We will transition from our short-term home-based learning plan to our long-term remote learning plan on March 30, 2020.

Our **food service program** continues through at least April 23, 2020. Meals can be picked up between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm. Breakfast and lunch are available.

With all the information and changes flying at us, please remember that the **United States Census** is also going on. This information is as important as ever as Census counts are used for school funding determinations like school lunch. This week, you likely received a letter in the mail giving you your instructions on how to participate. Participation takes minutes and only needs to be completed by one person in the household. Please take the time to be counted!

We have **School Board seats** on the April 7, 2020 ballot. We share the recommendation of our local election officials that residents consider participating using the absentee ballot process. Contact your town municipal clerk to request an absentee ballot.

We do want to emphasize the importance of all of us doing our part to limit our travel outside of our homes. As cases are increasing, we are seeing restrictions increase as well. It is realistic to expect that we might continue to see increased restrictions until cases level out and begin to decrease. The sooner we contain the spread; the sooner we can begin our progress back towards life as we used to know it.
